Angel Mission

Thank you to all the church members that supported us during Portage Health Foundation's Giving Tuesday! Those undesignated funds help us to balance our budget and our needs. We also recognize that our church family has gone above and beyond this past year by supporting our purchase and renovation of our new home. Thank you for all of your support!

Christmas 2022, we provided gifts for 210 children during our Angel Tree Program. Most all of those were sponsored, including several sponsored by church members, but we also sponsored a few directly with CCAM funds. We added socks, gloves, and underwear to many of the gift bags, as well.

We are using small grants from Portage Health Foundation, Keweenaw Area Community Foundation, and Portage Health Auxiliary for food pantry and assistance this winter. We have expanded our assistance somewhat beyond the usual rent, utilities, and gas for medical trips to other necessities. Aspirus Foundation gave us a small grant to improve heat to the food pantry room and they offered to give our managers and volunteers CPR/AED training to complement our new defibrillator.

In past years, the managers handled all programs with minor assistance from volunteers. Our current managers are meting out leadership roles in seasonal programs very effectively. Consequently, we average about 200 in-store volunteer hours monthly with program leadership roles beyond that. Angel Tree alone requires 300 hours of work. The board contributes a total of 100 hours monthly. Two of our longest serving volunteers are Lois Jambekar and Barb Brookhouse. Additionally, two board members come from our church family. It takes not just money, but volunteers to make Angel Mission successful.

If you are interested in volunteering or serving on a committee or on the board of directors, please let Lois, Barb, Sherry Middlemis-Brown, or Jim Northey know.

Very important addition: Although at the time I wrote the original report, our Angel Tree number was 210 and registration was closed, that was not the whole story. Our Angel Tree number is something over 240 now. Our late registrants were all excruciatingly painful stories. One was a family of six children, whose father passed away just a few days ago. They must not only cope with a lack of resources, but they are grieving such a horrific loss at Christmas time. We'll try to give their Christmas a small touch of joy by letting them know that others care. What a blessing to be able to do this for others.
